

May 29, 1898.

Today is Sunday and one
will be sitting here all day
There was one gentleman
come along this morning and
he wanted to talk to me after
he found I believed in the Bible
he said he would not talk
with me and another man

took the argument off his
hands so I asked him up
to our Room and we debated
untill one o'clock and he was
cornered so close that he could
not get out and he was
glad they come and called
us to ~~Breakfast~~ Dinner and
that was the only way he
could quit decent. He is
a very highly Educated
gentleman. and he said
you are too well learned
for me and I just had
to laugh at him to call

me Educated but that
is the way with all of
them as soon as they find
out they cant beat us they
say you are too well learned
for us I have had 2 or 3
long conversations on the
Bible to day.

May 30, 1898.

well Today is Decoration Day
and the City is full of People
from all Parts of County
we have been down on
the Streets several times
and we met several
People whom we were acquainted
with where we had been
visiting. in the Afternoon
the Shattuck Schools come
down (a military school for the
State located here) and their Band
and the City and County
Officials and they made
a grand Parade through

the Principals Streets of
the Town and then they
marched to the Park where
they held a meeting and
held some very good
speeches. in the evening
we walked up to schools
for the Deaf and Dumb also
for the Blind also a school
for Imbeciles or silly People
The State has most of these
Asylums located here the Stands
on the east side of the River
on a nice high Bluff over
looking the City. They are
fine Buildings mostly of Stone
but one I noticed was of
Brick, and I think they are
very Beautifully located, and
altogether they make a fine
sight looking down on
them from the hill above
after our Returness, we went
in and had a debate untill

Eleven o'clock and at
time we went to Bed having
spent a very Enjoyable day
May 13, 1898

To day in Braining and we
are not going out in to
the country. So we have spent
the day in Reading and in
debating the Principles of the
Gospel. and we had all of
the People who are boarding
at the same place as us
they came in to our Rooms
to hear us debate and we
had a quite a hot time
and the whole crowd decided
we were right we were
debating on the Doctrines of
Christ and after we was
through another man wanted
to talk with me but he
did not believe the bible
and he was an Infidel
so I could not or I

would not Debate with
him he said he knew and
under stood the Bible but
I soon found out he never
knew anything about it -
but altogether we have had
a Splendid day and these
are the kind of day that
learn us something

It's day we went out in to
the country and after we
got out about 4 miles on
to the shore of Cannon Lake
we sat down to Rest being
very tired as it is a warm
day. we are now sitting
on the same stump of
an old tree, in the shade
where I and Bro Peterson
sat along time ago, now the
trees are out by Bloom
and pretty and shady, and
in a little Pool of water

close to the Lake, where
the waves wash the water
up over the beach and
forms a little Pond in
the wood here I can see
a turtle laying ~~on~~ on a
log asleep in the sun
the minute they hear a
noise they fall in to the
water and disappear. well
we walked on to, wor said
and got Permission to hold
meeting in the hall. and
we could hardly find a
place to stop all night -
at last we got a place
to sleep but went to
bed with out supper
after we had walked
about 10 or 12 miles, but
that is all Right, we are
willing to suffer for the
gospel sake if only the
Lord will Bless us with

Health and strength that we may be able to go and travel from place to place that we may be his mouth piece in proclaiming the cause of truth to the people, well to night we have got a pretty good bed. but supper is slim.

War, Wis., June, 2, 1898.

To day we had a breakfast but I cant say it was a very hearty one, because we were not welcome, after a short breakfast we started for Fairbault, and after a hot walk we got in town about 10:30 and stayed until about 3 o'clock when we again set out for War, Wis. to hold meeting but O. did not we have to hot time it just seemed like it would

melt us but after we got out about 4 or 5 miles a man with a team came along and let us ride so we landed in War, Wis. again we got the keys and went and fixed up the hall and the people come out to hear us. they were all men folks, we had a splendid good meeting I spoke to them just one hour and I spoke hard till I was just ringing with when I sat down and then we dismissed and started for Fairbault 8 miles away for one time before we asked every body in the town if we could stop with them and they told us no, so we are going home again, and now we are here again after we walked 8 miles in to town

Making it in just two hours & and we are going to bed again with out supper after Preaching hard and walking 8 miles afterwards but I will say. I feel to thank god that we have had the Priviledge of going out and Proclaiming the Gospel of Christ unto the People for I am willing at all times to submit myself to the will of the father and whatever is the will of the Lord I am willing to do if only he will let me know

June 3. 1898

We are not going out to day as it is Saturday and it is awful hot they say it the Thermometer stood 110.2 degrees out where the men were working but it has been

a very Lonesome day we have had several folks come in and talk with us. and we have had several Gospel conversations and in the after noon we wrote some letters and sat and Read the Bible in the evening I was introduced to a gentleman from Chicago by the name of Jordan. he had been out to Utah and was acquainted with some of the most prominent men out there whom also I know. We had quite a nice conversation for about one hour. he gave us a good Recomend to every body. Well now we are going to bed and it is so warm that we can hardly breathe.

June 4, 1898.

To day we have not done anything all day it is so hot - & dear. We Registers 100 in the shade we have had several conversations to day on the Gospel some of the people here where we are stopping seems to be interested in our doctrine, and they all want to get and hear us talk on the Gospel to day the Parlor has been full all day and there is always one or the other of them asking us questions. So take it all to gether we have put in a good lively day in the evening I went out walking around town for when we are in town we don't get much exercise only when we walk around town.

June 5, 1898.

To day is Sunday so we are not going out. Besides it is raining. It is fast day today so we are going to fast. It has been very lonesome day nothing to do or nothing to read. In the afternoon we administered the sacrament to each other and then had supper at 10 o'clock after which we went out and had a short-walk so the day closes with nothing out of the ordinary it is now bed time but a young man that Rooms with us went a bought some oranges and some Bananas and invited us to help him eat them his name is Kickenup.

June 6, 1898.

We have not went out in the country to day for it looks like storm so we did not.

go out. in the evening after
supper we went out Tracting
and met with some nice
Peoples one lady Especially
said she was from Salt Lake
City and she knew just how
the mormons were and said
they were the best People in
the world and also that we
had the finest Country that
is under the sun. we distributed
about 20 tracts and then come
home and sat and talked
untill Bed time so now we
are going to bed. it looks like
Rain.

June 7. 1898.

well to day has been a very
buisy day. in the forenoon
we went and found a
new Place to stop it is called
the European Lodging House. we
made arrangements with Prop.
to come down he is a Swedish

man his name is Lindquist
this afternoon we will bring
our things down. but we are
sorry to leave Mrs Chambers she
is a dear good soul to us
and has been a good friend
to us but we think it is
best for us to move well
now we have moved all
of our things down here but
O dear if the folks up there
didnt cry when we left just
like we was their Brothers and
they would never get to see
us any more where we
are now is a very funny
Place indeed the Rooms are
all crooked. I dont like the
Place very much and I dont
think we will stay here very
long. but it just seems like
we had to leave the other
Place but I believe the Lord
winted us to go somewhere

else and make some new friends. so we will wait and see how it will turn out.

June 8, 1898.

To day we are waiting in Tokon. it is awful warm weather and in the evening when it is cool we go out Tracting to night we had pretty good success we visited 15 families and five of them Refused to take tracts one old fellow took one of the tracts and looked at it, and when he saw the Picture of the temple on the back of it he handed it back and said I want nothing to do with dot places. well now here we are to night at our new Boarding House and we are going to bed now

June 9, 1898.

well we got this morning with the intention of going out in to the country but it looks like it is going to Rain it looks so misty we are going to wait till after dinner and see how it looks. well now we have had dinner and we are going out to visit one of our friend Mr. Fox, well now we are here with our friends and they were glad to see us. we found them hoeing in the cornfield, but they quit and went to the house and we had supper and then we spent the evening talking on the gospel. we were not up late as I had the tooth ache and I went to bed early it looks like it was going to Rain
