

June 10. 1898.

This morning it is Raining
it has been Raining very
nearly all night - and every
thing is wet - This morning
I do not feel any better this
morning, pains are in my
head and face and they are
quite Annoying it is Raining
again at Groton awful cold
but we are going to have
some dinner and then the
Folk here. (Mr Fox and Mrs Fox)
are going to Town and we
are going to Ride with them
well now we are in Town
again we have just come in
the Roads were awful Muddy
we was glad to Ride in Oyles
we are going out to Board
with Mr Fox for a while and
we can then Rest up and
feel more like we are at
home and they are so kind to us

June 11. 1898.

we are Expecting to go out
to hold Meeting to night -
I am not feeling well
I have been quit under the
weather for 3 or 4 days. but
I am going out to night
for the very Anxious to
hold all the meetings we
can. well we walked
out 6 miles to Walcott
but we were disappointed
The Sunday School is using
the house to day and they
are going to use it to
morrow too, we cant hold
meeting to night so we are
disappointed the man in charge
of the house wrote to us but
we have never got the Postal
Card. but we are going back
to town the Folks gave us
supper first and were friendly
and seemed to be sorry to

Disappoint us but they said
to come back any time and
hold our meeting so here
we are again, to night - at
the Lodging house.

June, 12, 1898.
well to day is Sunday so
we did not get up until
we were called. After Break-
-fast I went up to our old
lodging house and spent an
hour or two visiting. It is a
very lonesome day. I bought
a newspaper and was reading
for a long time and now I
just come back from being
up on the street see and hearing
the Salvation Army. It is a
very hot day. While I am
writing my Companion is laying
on the bed asleep so I
thought I would just write up
my Journal. Then write a
letter or two to some friends

June, 13, 1898.
we have not done any thing
to day. I have not been
feeling well I have had the
Neuralgia for several nights
so I could not sleep good
I got a news Paper and Read
all the war news and went
and bought me some medicine
but in the after noon I
slept a while. And I went
around Town some in the
evening and went to bed

June, 14, 1898.
To day has been very dull
we have done nothing only
lay around and nothing has
happened worth writing about
we are just doing nothing
I am not feeling very good
yet and I did not think I
would go out to walk much
in the country till I felt
better. so that is keeping where

June 15, 1898.

To day is awful cold I never felt any thing like this home at this time of the year. Lots of people have on their winter Overcoats and now to day is going to be the last day of school at the Spattuck at that school the boys goes for one year and they are given Military training with thier other lessons untill they are at the end of the term well drilled we went yesterday up there to day and saw them making a contest for Prizes there was 3 companies of them and I tell you they made a grand Parade and went through all of the newspapers of our land they just done grand and they wound up by having a sham battle and

Finally they wound up by hanging out 2 colors and firing those there was a grand time there and people was there from all over the state. there was thousands of people came for miles to see the contest it was a cloudy day and very cool and Pleasant - so this is all to day

June 16, 1898.

we are going to day out to Dundas we are going to board out there with Mr Fox. we was up in town and saw Fox and we are going to ride out with him so now here we are out here to stay it will not be so awful handy for mail but we can go in once in a while I believe we will like it out here we can

go with our Coats of and
It wont seem so warm
then we can visit around
in the north part of this
County and not have to
walk so far. My teeth have
been aking all afternoon
Just awful but towards
night they got better in the
Evening we had a long
Gospel conversation with Mr.
Fox well this is all for to
day

June 17. 1898.

To day we have been hoing
in the garden and planting
corn it is awful hot. No
in the after noon we went
down to the River to fish
with Mr Fox we had not
been there long untill
we heard distant Thunder
and we could see a few
clouds in the north west

we went to the Buggie
and drove home as fast
as we could and we only
just got there in time
as the storm was coming
all Ready and it was
~~some~~ an awful hood storm
talk about Rain and Thunder
and Lightning we had it
for about two hours and
the way it Roared over head
was just awful, we could
hear a continual Roar
all the time of Thunder
and after dark the storm
had went south and we
watched the Flash of the
Lightning untill best time
it was the most grandest
looking light I ever saw
the way it kept up a
steady stream of Lightning
and then we could hear
the distant Roll of Thunder

well this is the end of
my book and now I
shall send this home
for my dear Folks at
home to Read so they can
see what we have been
doing. Then I will take
another Book and write
my Journal in that until
it is full and I will then
do the same with that
this is all and this is
my second Book or
Journal completed
June 19 1898
